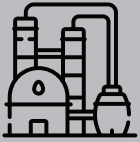

WHEN YOU FLUSH, WHERE DOES IT ALL GO?

Who are we?



- We provide sewer (wastewater) service to Park City and the Snyderville Basin areas.
- We are a governmental entity known as a Special District, similar to the Park City Fire District.

What do we do?



- We collect wastewater from homes and businesses with over 300 miles of underground wastewater pipes.
- Collected wastewater goes to a local advanced treatment plant (water reclamation facilities).
- We treat or “reclaim water” over 1 billion gallons each year.

How you pay for wastewater service?



- Each wastewater customer is sent a monthly wastewater bill. Your water provider also sends you a water bill separately.
- When a new home or business is built, the developer pays an impact fee that goes to build additional capacity at the treatment plants.

Interesting things the District is working on:

The District is participating in a state-wide project collecting wastewater samples and measuring the amount of SARS-CoV-2 virus (virus causing COVID-19) in the wastewater. This information is used by the Health Department as another source of information on the pandemic.

The District is conducting research in cooperation with Baylor University, to help determine the impact of pharmaceuticals and hormones on local fish populations.
